



NEW MEMBER INFORMATION SHEET

The Great Falls Garden Club is a charitable, educational and conservational club for persons interested in gardening, horticulture, floral design, and civic and environmental responsibility.

All members are asked to participate in the club activities. You will be asked to join at least one committee. Each committee has a Chairperson who would explain the activities of the committee/project to you.

COMMITTEE	ACTIVITIES
Blue Star Memorial	Maintain and replace the plants at the memorial site.
Membership	Welcome new members and orient them to the club. Help organize new member's activities.
Fundraising	Help organize projects that generate revenue for the club such as a plant sale. There are opportunities for new ideas for fundraising in this committee.
Library Meadow	Periodic maintenance requirements of the meadow plants.
Speakers Program	Help plan the Speakers program for the next year. The Vice President chairs this committee each year.
Outreach	Community liaison activities and projects.

Flower Show:

The club organizes a Flower Show every two years. If you volunteer to help with this project there are several members who will help you with any assignment you may receive.

Hospitality:

Each meeting three members provide light refreshments for the meeting. You will be asked to sign up for one meeting at least every other fiscal year. The list is made in the Spring for the following year.

Library Garden:

All members are expected to work on the Library Garden unless they are physically not able to do the work. A work schedule is prepared by an assigned member each Spring.

Other Committees:

The Executive and Finance committees have members with some experience of the club's Bylaws and finances. The Executive Committee includes the President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer. Other committees such as Fellowship, Awards, Historian and Web Master usually consists of only one member.

Any member of the Great Falls Garden Club can sponsor your membership. You will be required to attend 2 meetings before you will be voted on for membership. Annual dues are \$40.
