Youth Native Habitat Garden Grant

The Great Falls Garden Club will award a \$150 Grant to a local student to plant a Native Habitat Garden. The award recipient will be announced in May 2023.

1. APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS:

- a. Must be a student in Grades 5 – Grades 11
- b. Live in the 22066 zip code

2. HOW TO APPLY:

a. The application is available at the Great Falls Library or on the Club's website gfgardenclub.org

3. PROJECT REQUIREMENTS:

a. Design and plant a Native Habitat Garden to be at least 16 square feet in size. The garden must feature native plants.

b. The proposed garden should be planted by mid-June 2023.

c. Members of the Garden Club will be available to provide advice and answer questions, as needed, throughout the summer.

d. Grant recipient will keep a journal of pictures and observations (either written or electronic) of the project's progress throughout the summer and lessons learned from planting the Native Habitat Garden. The report is due September 1, 2023.
